The Planning and Zoning Commission was appointed by City Council to serve as the "Capital Improvement Advisory Committee" to advise the City Council on matters related to the Stormwater Impact Fee.

CITY OF WILLOW PARK STORMWATER IMPACT FEE STUDY

Land use information from the City's Comprehensive Plan, current population projections, and the City's Drainage Capital Improvement Plan (CIP), completed in December, 2019 were used as the basis for the determination of the impact fees.

The total capital improvement cost identified in the Drainage CIP was \$3,329,162.50 and, based on 2019 and 2029 utilization, the impact fee eligible portion was \$1,800,376.50. The projected number of service units on which to apply an impact fee were determined based on land use and impervious area for different types of development in Willow Park. The total projected number of service units, for a unit size of 1,000 square feet, is 25,911.

The costs for stormwater include the following:

•	Total Stormwater Capital Improvement Costs (all costs):	\$3,329,000
•	Total Eligible Stormwater Costs (new development eligible):	\$1,800,376
•	Total Stormwater Impact Fee Credit (50%):	\$900,188

Maximum Stormwater Impact Fee = (Total Eligible Costs – Credit) / (10-Year Growth in Service Units)

With Credit

= (\$1,800,376-\$900,188) / (25,911 Stormwater Service Units)

= \$34.74 per Stormwater Service Unit (1,000 sq. ft. impervious area)

\$34.74 is the recommended base Stormwater Impact Fee for the City of Willow Park.
