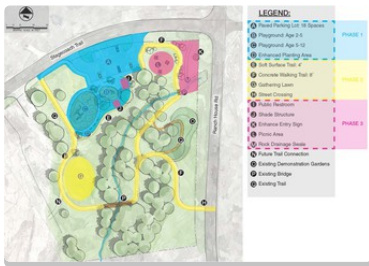

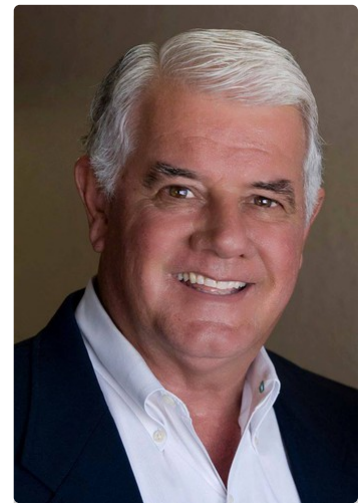
## Cross Timbers Park update

Bids are being taken during the month of August for Phase 1 construction of the new park at the corner of Ranch House Road and Stagecoach Trail. The city council is expected to select a firm during one of the September meetings, with construction to begin later in the fall. We hope to have the park open for families sometime in the spring of 2021.

## Sales Tax report

August 2020 sales tax came in at \$133,303, compared to \$105,756 at this time last year. Year to date, Willow Park has collected \$1,135,285. The city is expecting to exceed projected sales tax revenue for this fiscal year, which ends September 30.

*Please note that as of August 27, 2020, City of Willow Park water customers are still under Stage 2 guidelines. We will notify our customers via Blackboard, the city website, and the city Facebook when regular guidelines can resume.*

*Should further conservation be required, you will receive a notification from the city as to those measures.*

- Drip irrigation, soaker hoses, hand-held hoses and tree bubblers - exclusively for trees, shrubs, and foundations - is allowed

- Do not fill pools, hot tubs, and Jacuzzis
- Wait before establishing new turf and landscaping

*These guidelines apply to landscape watering with sprinklers or irrigation systems - before 10 a.m. and after 6 p.m. on your assigned day.*

# Willow Park Watering Guidelines

*Hose-end sprinklers are allowed ONLY before 10 a.m. or after 6 p.m. on your assigned days!*

**Ok every day:**

- Drip irrigation, soaker hose, handheld hose and tree bubblers, but only for two hours at a time
- Hand-held buckets and hoses with shut off valves for washing vehicles

**Please don't:**

- Hose paved areas or buildings, unless it's for fire protection
- Establish new turf without a variance from the city

*These rules are in place year-round. Should further conservation be required, you will receive a notification from the city as to those measures.*



